A versatile multi-instrumentalist musician and composer, Mulji brings together a world of works ranging from jazz standards to lush classical romance to baroque counterpoint.

During his Halifax debut, he will perform interpretations & variations of Bach, Beethoven, Schoenberg, Tatum, Gershwin, Mozart, Cage and Glass. At only 18, Afraaz Mulji has the wisdom and drive of someone much older. Mulji began travelling the world on his own at 13 years old and his travels through Africa, India and Europe brought him to Lunenburg, which he now calls home. His recent performances garnered glowing praise "His prodigious technique and playing style evoke the playing of Glenn Gould, Dave Brubeck, Chick Corea and Bill Evans. Combine all that with Afraaz's signature boundary pushing rhythmic, melodic and harmonic exploration led by his bold and daring imagination, then you have the one of a kind genius that is Afraaz." Mulji specializes in percussion and keyboard instruments like the organ, but says he can play almost any instrument in the world. Three years ago, Mulji had a highlight in his young musical career, when he had the opportunity to play the pipe organ at the famous Notre Dame Cathedral in Paris, France. His performance received a standing ovation.

Afraaz Mulji's journey around the world, has been fueled by his love for music. The young musical phenom recently performed to near sold out audiences at the venerable Lunenburg's St. John Anglican Church. Barbara Butler (Artistic and Managing Director of Musique Royale) says "Afraaz is a very talented, passionate, determined and hardworking musician with great potential. His ability to synthesize and retain information is at a very high level. Music is in his blood."
